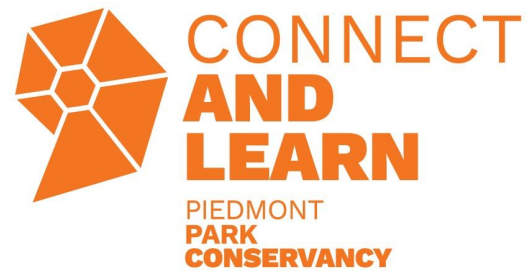


Bingo After Dark

Head outside after the sun goes down and use this fun bingo game to explore qualities of the night. Make sure to observe with your eyes and ears, not your hands. Also be sure to do this activity with a parent/guardian!



Notice a spider web in the moonlight	Identify sources of light other than the moon	Spot an insect that is crawling	Search the skies for stars	Make a noise that a nocturnal animal would
Listen for birds that are active at night	Name three critters that might come out at night	Identify something that an animal would eat	Look for something shiny	Look up at the moon
Think of three words to describe the weather	Observe flowers in the moonlight	Free space for being outdoors!	Listen for crickets chirping	Sit and listen for/look at nocturnal mammals
Observe clouds in the sky	Spot an insect that is flying	Find a burrow, nest, hive, or roost - but don't disturb it!	Look for your own shadow	Point out five different trees
Identify 3 different things that are green	Spot another planet in the night sky	Sketch a picture of what the sky looks like	Name five nature differences you see between night and day	Listen closely for frogs croaking
