

## **Picnic for Piedmont Park**

### **What is Picnic for Piedmont Park?**

This event is Piedmont Park Conservancy's socially-distanced version of Party for Piedmont Park, typically our annual fall fundraiser.

### **What time and date is the event?**

The Picnic runs from 6:30 pm to 10:00 pm on Wednesday, July 14.

### **Where is this event?**

This event will be held in Piedmont Park at the [Promenade](#). Guests should pick up their baskets at the Welcome Plaza (right outside of the parking garage) and head over to the Promenade **OR** venture out to other areas of the Park to enjoy their evening if they do not want to be at the Promenade. You may also take your basket home with you.

### **How can I get to this event?**

Guests may park in the ticketed deck we share with the Botanical Gardens (address is 1320 Monroe Drive, Atlanta, GA). Walking, biking, public transit and Uber/Lyft are also options. See our directions [here](#).

Once you arrive, you will be welcomed at the Welcome Plaza, which is adjacent to the **bottom** level of the parking deck and Magnolia Hall.

### **What does my ticket include?**

An individual ticket includes a meal for one guest, a keepsake insulated picnic basket, a craft cocktail, beer and wine options, and an evening with a DJ, an auction and games. A couple's ticket includes a meal for two guests, a keepsake insulated picnic basket, a craft cocktail, beer and wine options, and an evening with a DJ, an auction and games. Corporate and patron sponsors may have additional meals. \*Must be 21 and up to consume alcoholic beverages.

### **Is there a vegan/vegetarian meal available?**

Yes, vegan meals are available upon request. Meal preference requests will be emailed the week prior to ticket holders.

### **Can I bring my own chair(s)?**

Yes, guests are **encouraged** to bring their own blanket, chairs or other seating arrangements. Please do not bring tents or hammocks. \*Open-air tents **without** stakes are allowed throughout Piedmont Park, but **not on the Promenade**.

### **What is the dress code?**

The suggested attire is picnic casual (summer linens, sundresses, shorts), however, guests may wear whatever makes them feel comfortable.

### **Is my ticket tax-deductible?**

Yes, \$25 is tax deductible

**What is the rain plan?**

Upon rain, the Greystone venue will be available for guests. Otherwise, guests may take their baskets to-go or find other shelter in the Park. Greystone is adjacent to the pool and Mayor's Grove playground.

**May I walk-up to this event?**

Limited tickets will be available for purchase.
