

Prospective Vendor FAQ

How do I become a vendor?

Vendor applications are available [online](#) annually from December through mid February for the market season that follows. There is a non-refundable application fee of \$40. All vendors must reapply each year regardless of prior year status. Prospective vendors will be notified by the end of February if they have been approved or if additional information, documentation, product jury, or site visit is required.

What licenses and permits do I need?

All vendors must submit a valid Georgia business license and certificate of insurance. Additional licenses or permits may be required from the Department of Health or Department of Agriculture. You may apply without these but, if selected, you must submit them no later than one week prior to attending your first market. Vendors without proper documentation or current liability insurance will not be allowed.

What types of vendors are you looking for?

Green Market is primarily a market for consumable food products. We are especially interested in locally farmed produce, meat, eggs, and dairy products. We also allow prepared foods, locally produced artisanal grocery items, as well as a selection of handmade jewelry, arts, and crafts. Other categories may be allowed on a case by case basis. We also allow for activations and promotions on a case by case basis. Contact the [market manager](#) for these sponsorship opportunities.

Why wasn't I selected?

The Piedmont Park Green Market is a selective and competitive market with a limited footprint. Returning vendors are generally given priority over new applicants in the same category. Our turnover is extremely low.
